For this reason you may not hear from me for some time. Brethren, my team is in Uganda, East Africa, for missions, would you please send help with Swahili tracts. Let me hear from you. Brethren, Danny & Terri, my friends! How is Australia, and how are conditions? I hope you are doing well. Sadly, I am not OK because I have had a very bad accident and cannot travel anywhere, but my team will be in Uganda next week. Would you please help them with Swahili tracts. Bod bless you.
