***“Do not love the world or the things of the world, for if anyone loves the world, love of the Father is not in him. For all that is of the world, the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, are not of the Father but are of the world, and the world is passing away and its lusts with it. But those who do the will of the Father abide forever.”***
