Remember the four simple commands laid down in

Acts 15:28-29

, and the words of the Lord Jesus in

John 8:31-32

“If you continue in my word, you are truly my disciples. You shall know the truth, and the truth shall set you free.”

And once again in

John 8:36

,
“If the Son sets you free, then you are indeed free.”

While it is true that we must not allow others to impose man made rules on us, nevertheless, it is vital to also remember that the Master requires us to submit **to his authority in those who are in leadership** . The all

important thing here is for each of us for us to rely on our God and to

“Trust in the Lord with all of your heart and do not rely on your own insight. In all your ways acknowledge him and he will direct your paths“
